## Activities:

# Conference FAQ's

## How do I get from the airport to The Hyatt? Which Airport should I use?

There are a number of airports serving the Orange County / Los Angeles area.

We recommend flying into Orange County (John Wayne) which is about 8 miles away. A cab will cost approximately \$35.

Next closest airport is Long Beach which is about 18 miles. A cab will cost approximately \$50.

Los Angeles International Airport is about 38 miles away. A cab will cost approximately \$90 - \$120.

SuperShuttle and ExecuCar offer 10% discounts to attendees by using the code CLLMC.

SuperShuttle Fees are approximately: SNA - \$22, LGB - \$30 LAX - \$35 for the first passenger and \$9 for additional passengers.

## Should I rent a car?

Transportation will be provided for all conference activities that are not located at the Hyatt. Taxi service from the hotel is available. You can walk to the pier and downtown Huntington Beach, but if you wish to visit other areas a car is the best way to go. The normal parking fee of \$25 for parking has been waived for conference attendees staying at the hotel.

## How should I dress for the Factoring Conference?

Casual attire is recommended for all conference sessions, as well as the closing event.

## What is the weather like in Huntington Beach in April?

The average high in April is 64 (18) degrees with a low of 55 (13). The average rainfall amount is .7 inches (18.3mm).

## What meals are included with my conference registration?

On Thursday and Friday, your registration includes Continental Breakfast at 7:30am, two breaks during the day, and lunch at 12:30pm. If you choose to attend the Idea Exchange on Saturday morning, Continental Breakfast is included.
